

FRIENDS OF TURNHAM GREEN CONSTITUTION

This constitution was adopted on 10th July 2007

1. The name of the Association shall be Friends of Turnham Green
2. The objectives of the Association shall be to:
 - protect the common interests of the park
 - encourage local participation in the management and development of Friends of Turnham Green
 - arrange practical tasks
 - seek funding for maintenance and development
 - liase with Hounslow Council, CIP and other involved agencies in the management and development of the Park
3. The Association shall be non-Party and non-Sectarian.
4. The qualifications for membership of the Association shall be:-
 - Open to all interested people in the community **and**
 - By the payment of an annual subscription or of a donation of a households choice.

Every member has one vote.

5. The business of the Association shall be conducted by an Executive Committee consisting of the Chair, Treasurer and Secretary and a number of members who shall meet as often as the Officers consider necessary. Three members will form a quorum. All Officers shall be elected at the Annual or an Extraordinary General Meeting. The committee shall have power to co-opt.
6. The Executive Committee shall be empowered to raise funds and receive contributions and to implement the spending of the funds. The funds belonging to the Association shall be applied only in furthering the objectives.
7. The funds of the Association, including all donations, contributions and bequests, shall be paid into an account operated by the Executive

Committee in the name of the Association, **FRIENDS OF TURNHAM GREEN**. All cheques drawn on the account must be signed by at least two members of the Executive Committee.

8. The Accounts shall be closed on 31st December for Audit by one member of the Association who is not on the Executive Committee. All payments shall be made by the Treasurer or Chair on the authority of the Executive Committee.
9. The Annual General Meeting shall be held in March of each year, of which seven days notice must be given.
10. An Extraordinary General Meeting may be called at any time, either by the Executive Committee or by a requisition signed by at least six members who shall state the purpose of the request.
11. No alteration and/or addition to the Rules may be made except at the Annual General Meeting or at a General Meeting specifically convened for that purpose.
12. Notice of Motion must be received by the Secretary at least seven days before the General Meeting.
